BWPO Staff worked with the Betina Nicklas, Veterans Affairs Clearfield County, to put together the Veterans Expo & Career Fair held at the Clearfield County Fairgrounds on Tuesday, October 17, 2017 from 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM.
