**Highlights for this quarter –**

Junaida, T PID 3840163 was enrolled into the EARN, Adult and Dislocated worker programs on February 15, 2018 in the PA Clearfield CareerLink ©, Clearfield office. Although she faced many barriers when she was enrolled, she has overcome them and has been very successful in her unsubsidized employment. Junaida was hired at Community Resources for Independent Living on April 3, 2018 and continues to be employed with them. She has displayed great work skills and has become a valuable asset to the agency. She has met all of her Activity Compliance Rate requirements, Placement requirement and has just completed the requirement for May Retention. We are very proud of Junaida for her hard work, dedication and success.

Six youth and a North Central Youth Employment Counselor spent a beautiful spring day at Curwensville Lake cleaning up garbage along approximately 5 miles of the lake front trails. Two 6' x 12' trailer loads of garbage were picked up including about 20 old tires, parts of refrigerators and stoves and thousands of plastic bottles, aluminum cans and various debris that has washed down river onto the lakes banks when high water exists in the winter and early spring as the Dam holds back potential flood waters from destroying Curwensville and Clearfield along with many other communities along the West Branch of the Susquehanna River. The park ranger was delighted about the efforts put forth by this group of young people who care about our community. All of the work experience 'volunteers' would like to make this an annual event and was a truly awesome experience for all involved.

The BBU Environmental Services company has been working with the PA CareerLink© Clearfield County @Clearfield to assist them in finding good candidates. Currently BBU operates out of West Virginia but they have recently acquired several well pads in our local area. They would like to use the local workforce to maintain these sites rather than bringing in their workers from other states. There have been two Career fairs at the PA Careerlink© so far with another one planned on July 26<sup>th</sup>. They are currently trying to fill 8 positions at the first sight and then after they get it up and running they would like to staff a second site with about 14 more employees. They are currently looking for space to rent for the office staff that they would like to have in place here in Clearfield. We are currently assisting them with a plan that may benefit both parties.
