- ✓ Statewide Provider List – Insufficient number of schools/programs available in the region
- ✓ CWDS Access – mandated partners not able to share information on dual-enrolled customers
- ✓ Older dislocated workers lack practical knowledge and skills related to computers. In efforts to address this, we are purchasing Raspberry Pi computer systems and are developing workshops around basic usage and programming for use with job-seekers.
- ✓ EARN Family Based Activity Incentives are increasing this quarter
- ✓ EARN Customers are starting to attain the 9 month and 12 month incentive bench marks proving the success of the EARN program.

SUCCESS STORIES.....



Cameron County - Anthony was dislocated from employment and determined eligible for TRADE. He was then enrolled in WIOA Dislocated Worker services. He was accepted into the Penn State Dubois Associate Mechanical Engineering program. He started the program in August 2019 and will graduate in May 2021. He has utilized the Incentive Program recently implemented in the WIOA program. Anthony hopes to obtain full time employment in the engineering field.



Clearfield County – Clearfield - Richard was a dislocated worker who enrolled in WIOA services in September 2019. After his previous position did not work out, he was looking to make a career change. Richard participated in the CDL Program at the Clearfield County Career and Technology Center, and completed it 11/22/19. He did very well in the program and was hired almost immediately at Lansberry Trucking. In a recent email to his TDS, Richard commented “Thanks for your help with the schooling and with finding a job. Your office is just the greatest.”



Clearfield County – DuBois - Kelly Buchmiller met with TDS Tom Bundy from the DuBois CareerLink. She was on food stamps, a single mother of 5 with a work experience of being a cashier. Kelly wanted a better life for herself and her children and she was looking for funding to attend Triangle Tech for their Welding and Fabrication Technology program. Kelly was enrolled into the WIOA Adult program where she completed her workshops and TABE. Kelly was approved for funding to attend Triangle Tech, Kelly graduated from Triangle Tech on October 4 2019 with a QPA of 3.19 and soon afterwards she was hired by Miller Welding Solutions using the training that she received at Triangle Tech.



Elk County – Cassidy contacted the Elk County CareerLink in search of funding opportunities as she currently is enrolled in the Clearfield County Career and Technology Center’s Practical Nursing program. She enrolled as a WIOA Adult and was approved for funding to help offset some of her financial costs. She has utilized the supportive services that are available through WIOA services. She will complete her training July 2020 and will be eager to secure employment in the nursing field. Cassidy is very thankful for the support.

Jefferson County – Audrey Young was referred to the PA CareerLink for services by Clarion County Career Center in September of 2017. She attended the two year part time Practical Nurse program that started on 11/20/17 and she graduated on 10/18/2019. Audrey worked part time the entire time of training from a work experience at the CareerLink to a personal care assistant with Penn Highlands in Brookville. She graduated from the program magna cum laude with a 3.5 grade point average. Audrey successfully passed the state licensing test in November of 2019 and is now employed with Penn Highlands in Brookville as a LPN earning \$15.19 an hour or \$16.09 if she works the night shift.



McKean County –Andrew Sprester came to McKean County Career Link as a dislocated worker. Andrew was interested in completing an ITA for Buffalo Tractor Trailer Institute Inc. Andrew attended all workshops. Andrew spent his available time working with Title 2 on his remediation process, while attending truck driving school full time. In this picture Andrew’s smile says it all. Andrew completed his CDL class A training successfully, obtaining his CDL Class A license. Andrew also successfully completed remediation. Andrew is now employed full time at Dallas Morris Well service, using his CDL license.

Potter County – Sean Easton, a dislocated worker, came to the Potter County office back in February of this year looking for employment and training. Going through some off and on employment inspired him to pursue his goal of obtaining a CDL. After working with Title 1 and Title 2, he was enrolled at Buffalo Tractor Trailer Institute in Salamanca, NY and received his Certificate of Completion for CDL-A Training. Immediately after completing his training, he gained employment at Western Express Trucking Company. He is currently going through their 4-week training in Allentown, PA and should be on the road after the holidays!





She just wanted to start out by doing a work experience to make some money as she thought about her future plans. She got hired at the Emporium Senior Center for her work experience. Martina is still working at the Senior Center. Every time I go in to check on her, her supervisor has very kind words to say about her and her work ethic. Something that stands out to her supervisor is how extraordinarily well Martina gets along with the elderly individuals. Since Martina has started her work experience, she has figured out what she wants to do. Due to working at the senior center, she realized that she wants to go to CNA class and work at a nursing home. Martina continues to enjoy going to work and doing everything that she can to put a smile on the attendees at the Emporium Senior Center.



Clearfield County-Clearfield- Andrew Schwartz came to the Career Link wanting to enter the work force. He liked working hands on and being in the industry environment. Upon meeting with Andrew staff started the process and secured Andrew a Work Experience with Clearfield Wholesale Paper. Upon completion of his work experience the company wanted to keep Andrew on as a worker. Andrew is now hired with the business under our On the Job Training Program. She had been employed in the food industry and moved up to an assistant manager position but was hoping to find something more stable. She began an On-The-Job-Training with Paris Companies as a hanger/inspector in mid-September. Ashley has adjusted well to working in production full time and is happy to have a steady income for herself and her two young children.



Jefferson County- Autumn Sinclair was referred to the WIOA out of school youth program by Family Literacy in Jefferson County. Autumn had been attending classes there to achieve her GED. She was now ready to begin the testing process but needed assistance with the cost and help finding employment. Autumn started a work experience with Goodwill. Nathan has been very receptive to the program and has been great to work with.

When I first met Christian, I could tell that he was dedicated to fulfilling his goals of getting his GED and eventually finding long term employment. Since his enrollment, Christian has started working at West End Pizza in Johnsonburg. According to his work site supervisor, he is doing really well and catching on fast. Christian is also preparing to take his next GED test. He continues to put in time in order to reach his goal of obtaining his GED and finding long term employment.
