All three gentlemen are working with the WIOA TDS on seeking full time employment utilizing their new CDL Licenses.

Hope McCrea was a RESEA candidate that lost her live-in home health job due to her client passing away. Due to losing this job, Hope had become homeless, and was in desperate need of a new live-in job. I reached out to Angela to see if there were any services that we could provide for Hope while she was unemployed and homeless. She stated that at this time, there weren't any services that she could directly offer her. I made sure that she had all of the contact information for the Clearfield County Assistance office. While Hope was in my office during her RESEA orientation, she received a phone interview through Griswold Home Health Agency. Effective 3/16/2020, Hope was offered a job as a full time live-in home health aide through Griswold, and will be starting Friday, 3/20/2020. She will be working 16 hour days, 7 days a week, and will have an income of \$1096 per week. The job will also give her a place to live.

Sam Estright PID: 4829243 had an interview Wed 11 Mar 20 at 10:30am for the driver position we applied for previously and the hiring manager was very interested on the phone when informing Sam of the interview. We applied to the Altoona Skills driver position as well on Indeed.com. I was unable to follow-up with him due to the COVID-19 but will follow-up with a phone call Tue 31 Mar 20 to check job status.

In March, the PA CareerLink Closed the doors effective March 17, 2020 and will tentatively reopen on March 31, 2020. The PA CareerLink continues to provide services to our customers through telework. Arrangements have been made with the PA CareerLink Navigators to have "tracfones" and calls coming into the PA CareerLink are being directed to call our Navigators. In turn, the Navigators are routing calls to all available staff who are working from home. Customers are able to access almost all services.
